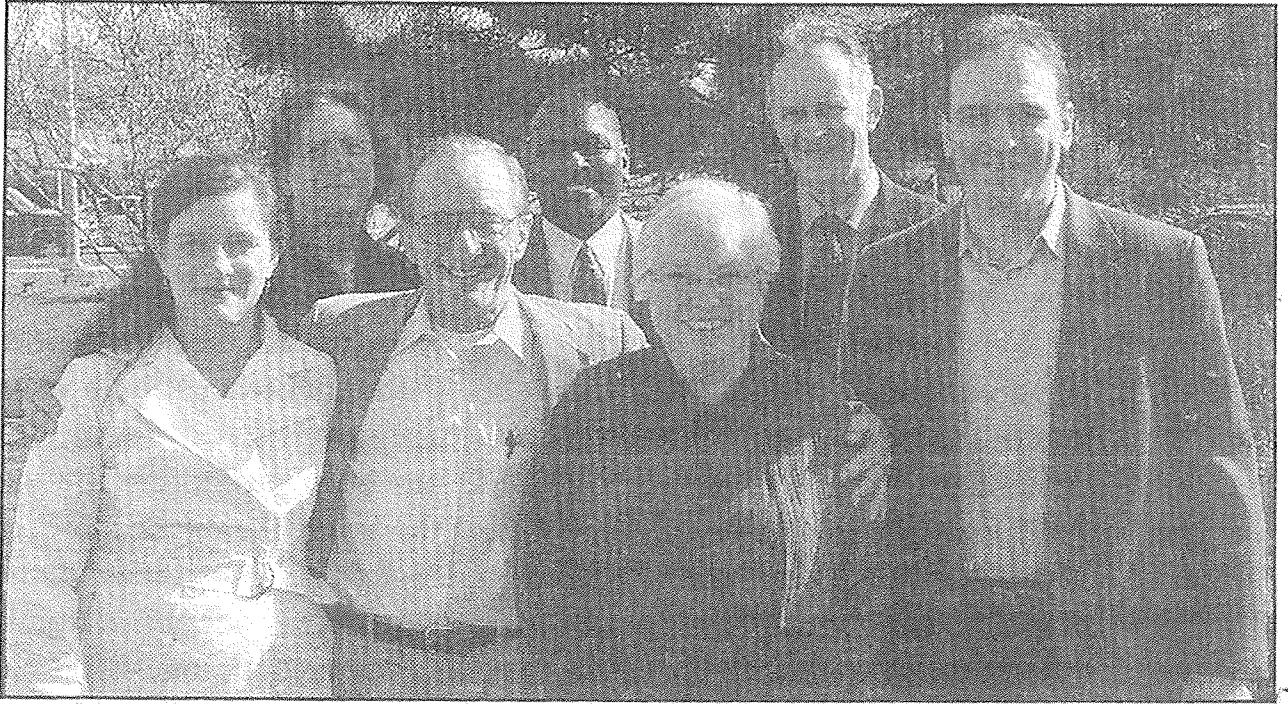


Burlington Partnership Awards Ceremony
